MOVEUPS

As per Section 19, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided the request is made to the Trial Secretary at the deadline below.

Verbal move ups will not be accepted. Moveups for each trial may be made prior to the moveup deadline via mail or email to: mygsdsni@optonline.net, GNYHC, c/o Kristin Siarkowicz, 124 Fairview Avenue, Bayport, NY 11705.

Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order or otherwise at the discretion of the secretary or Judge.

MAILED MOVEUPS: When mailing or emailing a moveup to us please just give the following information. Trial Name, Owner Name, Dog Call Name, Moveup for what days, Moving from, Moving to (PLEASE include STD or JWW).

Move ups are due in writing by **Monday June 28, 2010 at 6 pm**

Day-to-Day Moveups: are only allowed for dogs entered at the set of back-to-back agility trials for succeeding days of that set of back-to-back agility trials and must be submitted in writing at the trial within ½ hour of the last run of the trial day for the following day(s) and can not be conveyed via fax, email, or verbally to the trial secretary.

NOVICE MOVEUPS: Dogs or Handlers having attained ANY AKC Agility Title (Std, JWW, OR FAST class) **must be moved to the Nov B Classes** (Std, JWW and FAST classes) for all trials that have not reached the final closing date at the time that they get that first title. So be sure and contact the trial secretary to change your entry from Novice A to Novice B. Once a trial closing date has past, a dog cannot be moved from Nov A to Nov B. If the trial has already reached the closing date on the day the dog obtained its title, the dog shall remain in the class in which it was originally entered. The dog can also be moved up a level (Nov to Open) at the request of the owner subject to the normal move-up criteria.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO GNYHC

ENTRY FEE \$25.00 for the first entry of a dog; \$14.00 for each additional entry of the same dog per day. (Includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee for each run)

CLOSING DATE for entries **6:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 15, 2010**, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

REFUNDS: There shall be **no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are absent or dismissed from competition**, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. A refund will be given for any entered dog where a veterinarian determines that the dog should not run because of a medical condition. The same refund will be given where a medical doctor determines that the handler should not participate. Written verification must be presented to the trial secretary within 48 hours after the trial finishes. Refunds after closing date for bitches in season. There will be a \$5.00 processing fee for **ANY** refunds.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry fees will be refunded subject to a \$5.00 processing fee. Written verification from a veterinarian is required. **Notification for refund of bitches in season must be RECEIVED no later than 48 hrs after the end of the trial. A Veterinarian's note for dog must accompany any such refund request.**

ABOUT CONFIRMATIONS – If you would like a preliminary conformation prior to the issuance of the final conformation upon closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped **legal size** envelope along with your entry. E-mail preliminary confirmations will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form. **FINAL CONFIRMATIONS WILL BE EMAILED OUT ALSO and ARMBANDS PICKED UP AT THE TRIAL.**

****TRIAL REGULATIONS NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ****

THE TRIAL will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

FAX, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made shortly after the trial closes or limits are reached. Acknowledgment of entries will include confirmation notices.

NO ENTRY FEE will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds are subject to a \$5.00 processing fee.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

CONSULT FINAL CONFIRMATION FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

WALKTHRU & WARM-UP INFORMATION. No umbrellas allowed during walkthrus.

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

DOGS. This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to Judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring as stated in final conformation.

THE SAFETY OF THE DOG is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

IT IS EXPRESSELY UNDERSTOOD that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The GNYHC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The GNYHC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the GNYHC or any official thereof.

CRATES & TENTS may be left overnight; however, GNYHC and Suffolk County Farm will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

There will not be obstacle familiarization for Novice at this trial.

There will be a water hose available to cool your dogs down.

Shade under trees will be available for crating.

Absolutely NO DOGS ALLOWED beyond the staff parking lot. Anyone violating this rule will be asked to leave the trial site and no refund will be made.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST PICK UP AFTER THEIR DOGS!!

According to New York State Law, Rabies vaccination and dog license are mandatory.

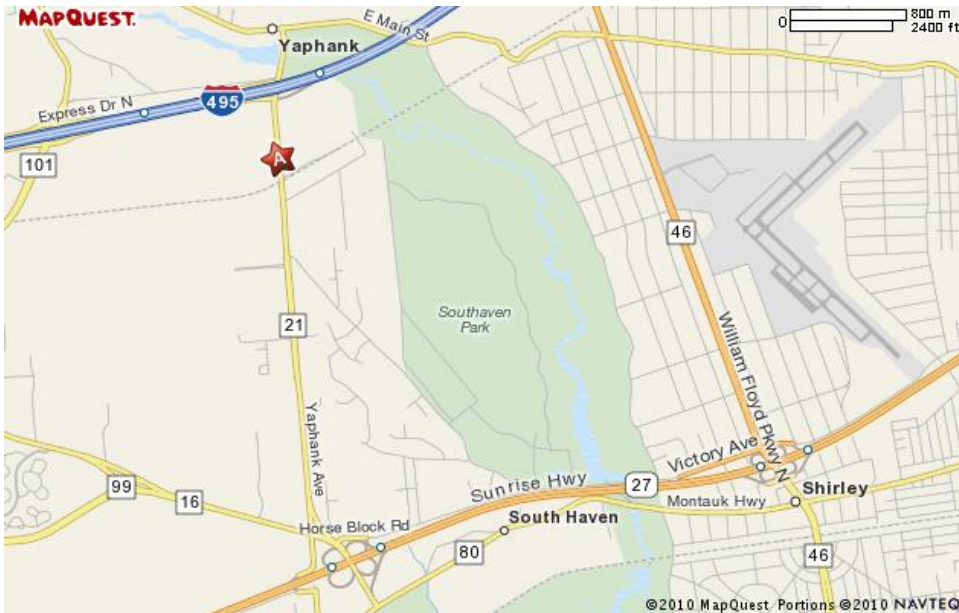

Long Island Expressway (495) to exit 67. At the light go south onto Yaphank Ave. and the entrance to the site is about ¼ mile on the right. It is just before the road goes uphill and *** directly across from the Department of Public Works. As you take the dirt road into the farm, parking will be on the left. The ring & tent setup is going to be detailed in your final confirmation.

Using Sunrise Highway (Rte. 27): to exit 57N (Horseblock Road West). Then bear right onto County Road 21N (Yaphank Ave. North). Travel 1 mile to the Cornell Cooperative Extension sign on the left. Turn left onto entrance road see *** above.
